MOTION:

Trustee Gallagher moved, seconded by Trustee Hansen, to appoint Trustee Glowiak as Acting Chair for the April 25, 2016 Board meeting. The motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.

1) HONORING JAMES NACHEL FOR 21 YEARS OF SERVICE

Acting Chair Glowiak noted that James Nachel was retiring from the Western Springs Department of Fire and EMS after 21 years of dedicated service.

Deputy Chief Mayor said Mr. Nachel joined the department as a paid-on-call member on February 14, 1995 and has been a valuable member serving not only as a firefighter, but as an Emergency Medical Technician, a CPR instructor and as a senior firefighter directing others on his company. Jim will be moving to Colorado with his wife, Gail, and Deputy Chief Mayor wished him well and thanked him for his dedicated service to the Village of Western Springs.

Deputy Chief Mayor asked several of Mr. Nachel's fellow members of the department to come forward to recognize Mr. Nachel. His retirement badge is ordered and will be provided to him soon. His helmet was presented to him in recognition of his service to the department. Acting Chair Glowiak thanked him for his service and wished him well.

EXPLANATION OF OMNIBUS VOTING PROCEDURE

Acting Chair Glowiak stated that the Illinois State Statutes allow a municipality to collectively vote on a group of ordinances, resolutions, and other motions, such as awards of contract, appointments, etc. This is known as an omnibus vote. All the items contained on the omnibus vote list have been previously discussed by the President and Board of Trustees on at least one occasion, and often on several occasions. By placing them on the omnibus vote list, a single vote may be taken to approve them. Prior to the omnibus vote, a Trustee may remove any item from the list and have it discussed and voted on separately.

Trustee Hansen asked to make corrections to the April 11, 2016, meeting minutes. Those changes will be made and the motion to approve these minutes would now be read "as amended".

11) MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT (Horvath)

A) Monthly Financial Report – March

Trustee Horvath thanked Director Turi for her memo as well as the monthly report for March 2016. The report includes a recap of all funds, a list of cash and investments and cash flow schedules. The 13th period disbursements report for March 2016 was included. The General Fund ended the quarter with a \$594,001.00 surplus. The Village received 51% of the 2015 property tax levy contributing to the month end surplus. There is a \$16,000.00 negative variance with regard to revenue versus expenses. License and permits for Timber Trails have not appeared as soon as anticipated but are expected to increase soon. Water consumption is a little less than expected. The Police Pension Fund is not quite on track but had a positive performance in March.

MOTION:

Trustee Horvath moved, seconded by Tymick, to approve the March 2016

monthly financial report as presented.

The motion passed on a roll call vote. Voting aye: Trustees Hansen, Horvath, Tymick, Allen, Gallagher and Glowiak. Voting nay: None. Absent: President Rodeghier.

Trustee Horvath reminded residents that Village Hall will be open on Saturday, April 30, 2016 from 8:30 a.m. until noon for residents to purchase vehicle stickers and animal tags. The stickers and tags need to be displayed by May 1, 2016.
