Dear Resident,

The Village sent a general roadway construction letter to your home, dated August 29, 2019 containing information on the asphalt resurfacing project occurring this fall. In that letter, it was stated that there would be no long-term loss of driveway access. However, after further review of the project it was determined that some homes may be more affected than others.

If you are receiving this letter, you may lose access to your driveway for longer than originally expected. A portion of the curb in front of your home and driveway is marked for removal and replacement due to its current condition. Additionally, the portion of your driveway apron affected by the curb replacement will be repaired. This will require access to your driveway to be removed for 5-10 days, depending on the extent of repairs required. On-street parking allowed 24/7 when you lose access to your driveway.

The start date for construction has not yet been determined but construction will occur this fall. Staff is scheduling a pre-construction meeting with Lindahl Brothers Inc., the company awarded the contract. Information on the start date and weekly construction updates can be found on the Village website at [www.wsprings.com/roads](http://www.wsprings.com/roads) as it becomes available. There you can view any updates on the project as well as follow the directions to sign up for e-mail and text message notifications using the "Notify Me" feature. The date that driveway access is lost will be communicated via the online notifications and door hangers at least 48 hours ahead of time.
