Dear Mr. Marrs:

We are in receipt of your letter of March 24, 2020 in which you responded to the letters Verizon had sent to your clients on March 23, 2020.

Verizon's sole objective in sending the March 23 letters to your clients was to address the small cell design guidelines that govern the placement of small wireless facilities in those municipalities. To that end, we included a memorandum outlining our concerns with those guidelines and identifying inconsistencies with applicable law. Verizon has not filed any applications at this time, and our letters made clear that we are committed to collaborating with municipalities during this time of uncertainty.

While many Verizon employees are considered essential workers and will continue to deploy much-needed network assets to enable our customers to engage in vital communications, we understand that others may not be in a position to continue working at this time. We remain open to discussing the design guidelines at your convenience, whether now or when the current health emergency subsides.
