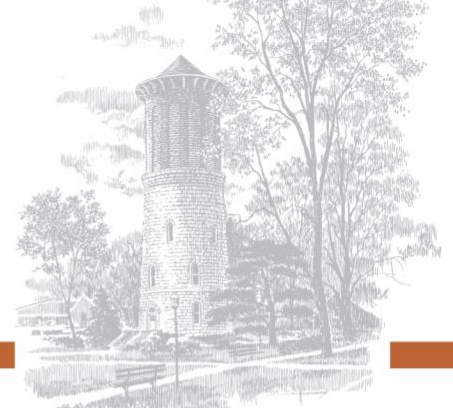

## Construction to Begin on 47<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Bridge:

- The Tollway has advised that construction of the pedestrian bridge near 47<sup>th</sup> Street is tentatively scheduled to begin today. The east- and west-bound sides of 47th Street, from Princeton Road to Fair Elms Road, will be limited to a single left lane. Additional details are available on the [Village website](#).

## Tollway Water/Sewer Work on Hillgrove:

- As part of the I-294 Expansion Project, the Illinois Tollway is replacing watermains and completing sewer work on Hillgrove Avenue between the Public Works facility and Prospect Avenue. The work is anticipated to begin this week and is scheduled to conclude by the end of the year. A portion of Hillgrove Avenue will be closed, and a flagger will be used to maintain one lane of traffic.
