



BNSF RAILWAY BRIDGE PROJECT

Western Springs Metra Station Parking Impacts



Project Overview

The Illinois Tollway is reconstructing the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railway Bridge, which carries the triple-track railroad over the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) between Hinsdale and Western Springs, to accommodate the widening of the Central Tri-State Tollway (I-294).

Work in 2019 and 2020 includes construction of a bypass bridge that will allow for uninterrupted commuter rail and freight operations during bridge reconstruction. Once the bypass bridge is complete, the existing bridge will be removed and rebuilt in 2021 and 2022.

Commuter Impact

A portion of commuter permit parking on Burlington Avenue between Central Avenue and Waldo Erickson Drive will be closed during construction. Overflow permit commuter parking will be available at the Western Springs Service Club (pool) lot at 1300 Hillgrove Avenue, beginning September 3. Permits will be enforced.
