Western Springs Police Arrest Chicago Man for Residential Burglary

WESTERN SPRINGS, IL, March 4, 2020, – On Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at approximately 1:00 p.m., the Western Springs Police, arrested and filed Felony criminal complaints against a 32-year old Chicago man for Residential Burglary.

Peter Miller of 6701 N Olmsted Ave., Chicago, IL was arrested after a 28-month investigation that resulted in probable cause for an arrest stemming from a residential burglary that occurred on November 4, 2017, in the 4000 block of Gilbert Avenue in Western Springs. The offender made forced entry into a rear basement door and removed cash and jewelry.

Miller was charged with one count of Residential Burglary, a Class 1 Felony.

Miller was taken to the Cook County 5th District Circuit Court on March 4, 2020, where Judge Gallagher set bond at \$100,000.

Members of the public are reminded that a complaint contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
