ACCESS TO VILLAGE SERVICES

Key Information on Village Operations

1. Village Hall and offices will be closed to walk-in traffic, with a public drop box available in the lobby during business hours.
2. Community Development will be closed to walk-in traffic with a drop box available during business hours.
3. Recreation Center will be closed, except for voting, on March 17 – with program registration taking place online.
4. Police department will allow residents to file reports by phone to their non-emergency number. The phone in the lobby of Village Hall remains accessible, and will dial directly to LTACC's non-emergency line.



For the safety of the community and Village staff, and to help prevent the spread of illness, we ask that the community limit physical interactions until further notice. We appreciate your patience during this time!

POLICE, FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES

In Western Springs, please call (708) 246-8540 for non-emergency services. The Police Department will also be temporarily suspending all in-person service functions such as fingerprinting services, building tours, and child safety seat checks.

9-1-1 dispatchers will ask a series of questions to each caller, and emergency medical personnel may limit exposure to patients by wearing protective clothing.
