





# PROJECT OVERVIEW

- ▶ Concrete Reconstruction of existing roadway
- ▶ New curb & gutter and 12' lanes
- ▶ Driveway aprons removed and replaced
- ▶ Installation of 8" ductile iron watermain
- ▶ 1.5" water services from new water main to buffalo box (located in parkway)
- ▶ Spot sewer repairs
- ▶ American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliant crosswalks





# PROJECT TIMELINE

## ▶ **Pre-Construction**

- ▶ Project bids are scheduled to be opened on May 7, 2020
- ▶ Tentatively planned to be awarded by the Village Board on May 18, 2020

## ▶ **Stage 1: Mid/Late June – Early August**

- ▶ Installation of water main and spot sewer repair
- ▶ Installation of new sewer structures

## ▶ **Stage 2: Early August – Early September**

- ▶ Half of roadway and driveway apron removal and replacement

## ▶ **Stage 3: Early September – Early October**

- ▶ Second half of roadway and driveway apron removal and replacement
- ▶ Intersection reconstructions

## ▶ **Stage 4: End of August – November**

- ▶ Installation of ADA sidewalk crossings
- ▶ Topsoil and new sod installation
- ▶ Pavement striping

**Construction schedule is estimated and may change**

# RESIDENT IMPACTS - CONSTRUCTION HOURS

- ▶ **Weekday: 7:30AM –7:00PM**

- ▶ *Certain phases of construction (concrete pours, pavement striping, etc.) may require the contractor to start earlier*

- ▶ **Saturdays: 9:00AM – 6:00PM**

- ▶ *Contractor is required to notify the Village one week prior*

- ▶ **Sundays: No Work Allowed (unless a permit is acquired)**

- ▶ Village Board, may allow changes to the start time in emergency or time dependent situations

# RESIDENT IMPACTS – TRAFFIC AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE

## ▶ Road Access

- ▶ Outside of construction hours, one-way traffic will always be available
- ▶ Limited access during construction hours

## ▶ Equipment Storage

- ▶ All equipment and materials will be stored within Village right-of-way
- ▶ May be barricaded/taped off in street or in the parkway

## ▶ Golf Cart Service

- ▶ Public Works operated pick-up/drop-off
- ▶ Available Monday-Friday (7:30AM – 4:00PM)

# RESIDENT IMPACTS – WATER SERVICE DISRUPTION

## ▶ **Scheduled Disruptions**


- ▶ 1-2 hours while the contractor is connecting your home to the new water main
- ▶ 4+ hours while contractor connects new main to existing water main system

## ▶ **Unscheduled Disruptions**

- ▶ 1-2 hours if contractor breaks your water service during construction
- ▶ 4+ hours if contractor breaks existing 4" water main during construction

# RESIDENT IMPACTS – DRIVEWAY APRONS AND CARRIAGE WALKS

- ▶ Existing concrete and asphalt driveways will be replaced with concrete, unless asphalt is requested in writing from the resident (**Municipal Code 8-2-8**)
- ▶ Brick paver driveways will be re-installed, unless otherwise requested from the resident
- ▶ Specialty driveway aprons (ex. stamped concrete, slate/bluestone, etc.) will be replaced with standard concrete. Residents may choose to replace their apron with specialty materials at their own cost
- ▶ Carriage walks, or the short walkway between the sidewalk and curb, will be removed and replaced, unless otherwise specified by the resident
- ▶ Any stairs located in the parkway will be removed and not replaced



# RESIDENT IMPACTS – SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

- ▶ All sprinkler systems within the Village right-of-way, and 3 Feet behind the sidewalk should be visibly marked before construction begins
- ▶ Damage to marked sprinkler systems will be repaired by the Village at the end of the project
- ▶ Damage to unmarked sprinkler systems will not be repaired by the Village



# CLAUSEN AVENUE LEAD WATER SERVICES UPDATE

- ▶ Lead water service letter sent on January 27, 2020. Resident meeting occurred on February 19, 2020
- ▶ Village has received written notice from 6 of the 22 homes with lead/unknown services on their choice to replace or keep the remaining lead water service
- ▶ All 22 homes need to respond before the project start date. A copy of the letter and waiver are available at [www.wsprings.com/roads](http://www.wsprings.com/roads).
- ▶ Baseline lead testing to occur May 18<sup>th</sup>/May 19<sup>th</sup> for homes with lead services
  - ▶ Sample bottle will be dropped off with instructions. Bottles will be picked up on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.
