

COVID-19:

- Governor Pritzker announced [revised state guidelines](#) for restaurant and bar establishments. [BEDS Plus Care](#) is working with the Illinois Housing Development Authority to assist residents who have fallen behind on their mortgage as a result of a COVID-19 event.
