Complainant was owed a refund of \$750 for dissatisfaction with virus software. The software company deposited over \$9000 into complainant's bank account, then asked complainant to wire money from their account to make up for the over-refund. The complainant did a second wire transfer when the software company stated the first wire transfer was rejected. The refund did not get deposited in the complainant's account, but the two withdrawals did go through, so the complainant suffered financial loss of over \$14,000.
