Scope of Construction and Driveway Impacts

This project includes the grinding and resurfacing of the current pavement, spot replacement and readjustment of manholes and drainage structures, minor sidewalk improvements, and spot curb and gutter replacement. Spot curb replacement is extensive throughout this project

and will impact driveway access at most homes. Residents can expect to lose driveway access for 5-10 days while the contractor replaces the curb and repairs driveway aprons. On-street parking will be allowed, 24/7, on adjacent side streets during the duration of the project. Loss of driveway access will be communicated by Village staff via an online construction update and by the contractor via a physical notice at least 48 hours ahead of time.

Private Improvements in Public Right-of-Way

The Village owned right-of-way encompasses 66', or 33' in both directions from the street center line. The right-of-way limits typically span 1' behind the private side of the sidewalk on both sides of the street. Private systems (i.e. electric fences, sprinkler systems, landscaping improvements) are sometimes located within this public right-of-way, often underground, with permission from the Village. These systems are the sole responsibility of the homeowner per **Municipal Code 8-2-9: Private Improvements in the Public Right of Way**. The Village is not liable for any damages to private systems located within the public right-of-way.

Residents are encouraged to mark any private systems with flags or paint prior to the project start date. To be safe, the Village recommends marking any systems within the entire right-of-way, and those within 5' of any sidewalk, curb or driveway. The contractors will do their best to not cause damage to your private system. However, should repairs be necessary, the property owner is ultimately responsible.
