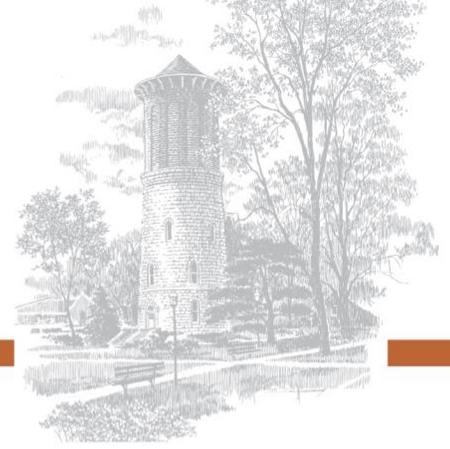

ComEd Scam Alert:

- ComEd reminds customers that as pandemic restrictions are lifting, imposters are returning to tactics that target customers at their homes and businesses. ComEd has issued a [news release](#) that shares helpful tips to assist customers in identifying scams. Solicitors and peddlers must submit a license application and, if approved, receive a permit from the Village, except for certain groups or organizations that are exempt from the permitting requirements because of state or federal law or court decisions. Well #5 is Operational:

- Well #5 is now operational and awaiting permitting by the IEPA (a 50-60 day process). During this waiting period, the Village intends to install the flow meter and complete all testing. The new deep well adds needed redundancy to our water system and allows us to forgo use of the one remaining shallow well.
