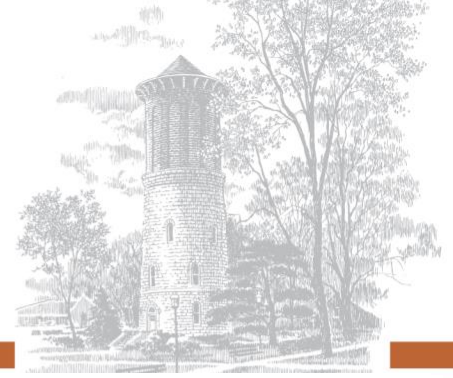

## Recreation Department News:

## Leaf Pick-Up and Yard Waste Collection:

- The Village's [Leaf Collection Program](#) continues, running through early December. While there isn't a specific schedule by neighborhood (and collection depends largely on how many leaves are put out on any given day), Public Works staff try to circulate around the entire Village at least once a week.
- LRS continues to collect [yard waste](#) bags with stickers, through the end of November. Yard waste collection resumes in April.

## 47<sup>th</sup> Street Lane Closure over I-294:

- The Illinois Tollway notified the Village that westbound 47th Street, between Fair Elms Avenue and Princeton Road in Hinsdale, will be reduced to a single lane, with two lanes remaining open on eastbound 47th Street. Traffic will remain in this configuration through the spring. On I-294, traffic in this area is currently shifted and will remain in this configuration through the end of the year. Traffic shifts on the Tollway and local roads are necessary to accommodate the construction of piers and abutments for the new pedestrian bridge.
