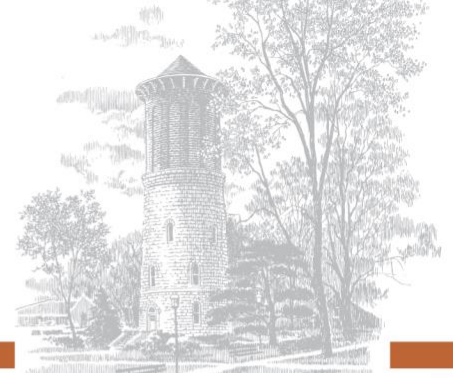

Well #5 Update:

- Integration of the Well #5 flow meter is complete and the Well has successfully completed one of the treatment processes for community-wide distribution. Follow-up and final testing is expected in mid-December, and Well #5 is expected to be fully operational by the end of 2021.

Return to Virtual Meetings in 2022:

- In an effort to keep staff and Board members as safe as possible, while encouraging broader public participation at meetings, at the December 6 Board meeting the Trustees concurred with my recommendation to resume virtual meetings in 2022. Starting in January, [public meetings](#) will be held via Zoom, with a link being published on the Village website in advance of the meeting. I encourage you and anyone wishing to participate in public meetings to do so by Zoom or by phone from the comfort of your home. Should you wish to attend a meeting in person, you are welcome to do so, so long as you comply with masking, social distancing, and any other indoor mandates deemed prudent at the time of the meeting. Virtual meetings are possible due to an interpretation of the Open Meetings Act under the Governor's Executive Orders regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.

Christmas Tree Curbside Collection:

- LRS will collect non-artificial Christmas trees from the curb during the first 2 weeks of January. Curbside tree pickup is at no charge during this period, but after January 15 each tree will require 1 sticker. Trees must be real (not artificial), not in bags, and free from tinsel, lights, and ornaments. This information is also available on the [Village calendar](#).
